ORDINANCE NO. 2026-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, REGARDING STREET NAMING AND PROPERTY NUMBERING; AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, SECTION 70-55 THROUGH 70-58; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

1. Summary of the proposed ordinance

The current street naming and property numbering regulations do not align with current practices and interagency emergency response systems and contain outdated provisions that are no longer applicable to the addressing system. The proposed amendments align with current practices that have advanced due to technology, address government facilities with multiple buildings, provide for limited administrative authority to depart from certain provisions when such departures are in alignment with emergency response system requirements and provide for due process for those aggrieved by addressing decisions.
