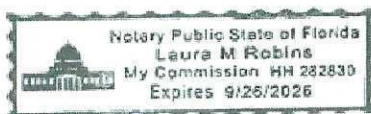

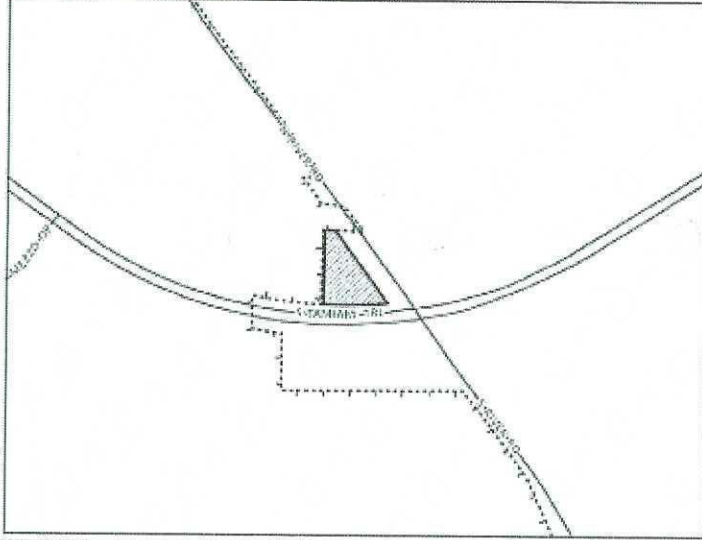

IT IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning and Zoning Advisory Board designated as the Local Planning Agency (LPA) will hold a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. or shortly thereafter, on **Thursday, February 15, 2024** in the City Chambers located at 4970 City Hall Boulevard, North Port, Florida to consider and act upon **Annexation Petition ANX-23-129**; voluntary annexation of  $\approx 2.491$  acres of land into the City of North Port.

IT IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Commission of the City of North Port will hold a first reading public hearing at 6:00 p.m. or shortly thereafter, on **Tuesday, February 20, 2024** and a second reading public hearing at 10:00 a.m. or shortly thereafter, on **Tuesday, March 5, 2024** in the City Chambers located at 4970 City Hall Boulevard, North Port, Florida to consider and act upon the adoption of the following proposed City Ordinance:

**ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, ANNEXING  $\approx 2.491$  ACRES OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF NORTH RIVER ROAD AND SOUTH TAMMIANI TRAIL IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE EXISTING CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA; REDEFINING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT TO INCLUDE THE PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR ANNEXXATION; AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP; PROVIDING FOR ASSESSMENT AND TAXATION; PROVIDING FOR FILING OF DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**



The Proposed ANX-23-129 boundary of the area is depicted on this map. The site is generally located on the northwest corner of North River Road and South Tamiami Trail. The proposed site contains  $\approx 2.491$  acres.

This notice is published pursuant to the requirements of Section 171.044 Voluntary Annexation Florida Statutes; accordingly, the publication of same must be accomplished a week for two (2) consecutive weeks prior to the meeting at which the above Ordinance is to be considered and acted upon. The proposed Ordinance with complete description by metes and bounds is on file in the Office of the City Clerk for inspection by the public between the hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. A file pertinent to ANX-23-129 is on file in the City of North Port Development Services Department, Planning & Zoning Division for inspection by the public between hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Interested parties may attend the meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed Petition/Ordinance.

A public hearing may be continued from time to time.

A stenographic record by a certified court reporter is made of these meetings. Accordingly, anyone seeking to appeal any decisions involving the matters noticed herein be responsible for making a verbatim record of the testimony and evidence at these meetings upon which any appeal is to be based.

**PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990** - The North Port City Hall is wheelchair accessible. Special parking is available on the west side of City Hall and the building may be accessed from the parking area. Persons with hearing difficulties should contact the City Clerk to obtain a hearing device for use during meetings.
