Rules and Information:

The official basketball rules adopted by the National Federation of the State High School Association shall govern play with the following exceptions:

General Information:

- Playing time will be 40 minutes, made up of two 20 halves of running time, with the clock being stopped the last 2 minutes of each half. If one team is ahead by more than 25 points the remainder of the halves will be a running clock.
 - Overtime- The overtime period will begin with a jump ball and is a 2-minute stop time period. If the game is still tied after 2 minutes another 2-minute stop time period will be played. If still tied, the game will go into sudden victory overtime with a team only needing 1 point for a victory.
- Each team will have 2 time-outs per half. Time outs not used in the first half will <u>not</u> carry over to the second half. Each team will be awarded 1 time out in overtime. Unused timeouts in regulation will not carry over to overtime.
- A team may begin to play the game with 4 players. If a player gets disqualified the team may continue to play with less than 4 players.

- Please notify the Recreation Coordinator if your team cannot make the game. Teams are required to give a minimum of one-week notice if they need to reschedule a game, there is no guarantee games will be rescheduled. Please note all schedule conflicts at registration. Otherwise team may be subject to forfeit. (A team shall be fined \$20 for a forfeited game, payable by 5pm, the day before the next league game.) Forfeits will be called at 15 minutes after the scheduled game time.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including, but not limited to foul language, out of control tempers or unnecessary roughness, will not be tolerated. Please remember this is a recreational league. On and off court, you are a representative of your team. Please be respectful when playing or watching. Failure to comply with these rules may result in suspension or removal from the league.

Schedules and Standings:

- Schedules will be sent to team managers and posted online. The standings and league statistics will be posted on the league website at <u>npabl.leaguerepublic.com</u>
- If a team has any schedule conflicts, please express that during registration. Request will be reviewed on a case by case basis but are not guaranteed.

Rules:

- All players must check-in at the scorer's table prior to each game. This is how we will keep track
 of the 4-game minimum rule. If a player is injured, yet still attends the game please check-in to
 count towards minimum. Doctors note may also help count towards minimum.
- Players wanting to enter the game as subs must kneel or sit down near the scorer's table and at no time block the scorekeeper's view of the game.
- If a player's conduct disrupts the game, the game will be stopped. The game clock will continue to run for the time it takes to resolve the issue.
- If at any time a player in the game is bleeding, they must leave the game until the bleeding has completely stopped and the wound is covered. Excessive blood on the uniform requires the player to change clothing.
- Consumption of any alcoholic beverage on City property is prohibited. Persons found in violation
 of this rule will be subject to citation and removal from the league.

Rosters:

- Players may only be on one team roster
- All players must be 16 years old or older before playing in their first game of the season. If a player is under 18, they must have a signed parent waiver on file.

- Players must play in a minimum of 4 games to be eligible for playoffs.
 - Adding players that will not meet the 4-week minimum is at the discretion of the Recreation Coordinator and must be discussed prior to week 4.
- Rosters will lock after your team's 5th game, new players cannot be added after the 5th game unless unforeseen circumstances arrive, please see Recreation Coordinator.

Fouls:

- The bonus is in effect on the seventh team foul and the double bonus is in effect on the tenth team foul. Technical fouls will be charged the same as a personal foul against the player and the team.
- Any player receiving five (5) personal fouls will be disqualified from the game.
- Any player receiving two (2) technical fouls in a game will be ejected from that game and required to leave the facility. That player will also be suspended from their team's next played game. Any player ejected from a game for fighting will be suspended for the rest of the season.
 - Additionally, Suspended players cannot attend the team's next played game.
- Coaches or captains must remain in the coach's box. Referees may assess a technical if a coach or captain leaves the area of the coach's box.

Uniforms:

- Teams must have similar colored jerseys/t-shirts with an easily visible number on the front or back. Multiple players cannot wear the same number(s). Each player without a similar colored jersey/t-shirt and/or numbered jersey/t-shirt will receive a technical foul upon entering the game.
- No duct tape or tape of any kind can be used as numbers on shirts. Numbers must be permanently attached to the jersey/t-shirt either printed on, stitched, or ironed on.
- No jewelry of any kind is allowed while playing.

Tie Breakers and Seeding Process:

- Playoffs will be single elimination with all teams entering playoffs.
- Playoff seeding will be based on the following (if a tie, we will use the following to break the tie to seed the playoffs):
 - 1. Record We will be seeding teams first by best record, based on regular season standings.
 - 2. Head to Head In case of a tie it will be head to head if the two teams have played each other, the winning team breaks the tie.

- 3. Season Points For -If the two teams have not played each other, we will count points scored throughout the season and the team who scored the most points will be given the higher seed.
- 4. Season Points Against If both teams have the same points for the season, we will then look at points scored against the team and the team with the lowest amount scored against them throughout the season will be given the higher seed.
- 5. If that is also the same, we will have a coin flip to determine the seed.

COVID-19 prevention re-entry plan

City of North Port Parks & Recreation

The following procedures and guidelines will be communicated and enforced with the objective to stop the spread of COVID-19.

Pre-Game communication:

We will communicate to all participants:

- Players that are not feeling well will be asked to stay home.
- Any player reporting or demonstrating symptoms of illness at any point will be asked to leave.
- Players that have had close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 will only be permitted to play if:
 - The player has not had a documented case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
 - The player is not currently demonstrating or suffering from any ill symptoms in the last 48 hours.
- Players especially on the bench will be asked to physical distance and when physical distance is not possible be asked to wear masks.
- Players are encouraged to sanitize or wash their hands as much as possible.
- Teams will not be permitted to shake hands at the end of games.

Equipment and facilities:

- Players should bring their own equipment (hand sanitizer, water bottle, towels, etc.).
- Surfaces that may be contacted and shared by players
 - Staff will sanitize the basketball itself in-between halves.
 - Staff will sanitize the benches in-between games.
- Staff will have spare hand sanitizer readily available for teams.
